The Inspire Performance Collective (IPC) is an extension opportunity for young dancers and singers, providing a platform for them to be part of a valued performance ensemble. Under the guidance of talented choreographers and mentors, students in the IPC have the chance to develop their dance abilities, confidence, creativity, teamwork, and leadership skills.

The program offers numerous performance opportunities throughout the year including participation in eisteddfod and community performances, plus additional experiences such as social events and excursions, audition skills workshops with industry guests, and an annual IPC Christmas show.

The aim of the IPC program is to foster a supportive learning and creative community, where students with a passion for the Arts and performance can: grow in their technique and strength across various genres of Dance and Musical Theatre, build valuable friendships and connection, and pursue their creative gifts and interests.



IPC Team Values

2/ Encouraging and uplifting our IPC team members with positive words & actions; 3/ Attending all weekly classes to continue developing our technique, creating amazing performance works for the stage, and building friendship with our teammates; 4/ When representing Inspire at public events, we support everyone that we meet with kind words and actions; we lend a hand where needed and are a role model for younger students; we listen out for teachers' instructions and present wellgroomed in the Inspire team uniform and costumes.

Private Tuition + Soloist Opportunities

Further private training opportunities are provided for performers desiring more competitive performance experience as a soloist and/or duet capacity. Solo performance work is in addition to being a member of an IPC Performance Ensemble. Our talented team provide solo or duet creations across the following genres: Jazz, Hip Hop, Contemporary, Lyrical, Classical Ballet, Tap, Song & Dance, Vocal

IPC Annual Program Inclusions

- 3-4 Eisteddfod events per year;
- 2-3 Community events per year;
- IPC Family Showcase (in-studio: an opportunity for family & friends to view all our performance items before we take to the stage!)
- All additional group rehearsals, including vocal recording sessions for Musical Theatre students;
- Annual Christmas Show: 2 x local performances of a 30min show we create in November-December;
- An additional performance item in Inspire's whole school end of year concert, as well as the opportunity to pursue lead roles;
- 2 x Social events: a 'Welcome to IPC' event (Jan/Feb) and a Christmas celebration (December);
- A Workshop Experience with a Special Guest (November/December);
- Your own IPC 2025 planner and journal for note-taking throughout the year;
- Optional Add-On: Excursion to a local Theatre society show or Cinema outing



IPC Membership Pricing

Annual Membership Fee: \$375 + GST (Or pay monthly instalments via Ezi-Debit: \$37.50 + GST p/month, February - December 2025)

The IPC membership fee is a one-time payment covering all IPC rehearsals, community and competition entries, the Christmas Show and fun extras (please note: this is on top of your weekly class tuition fees).

Additional Costs

- IPC Team Jersey (billed Feb/March): to wear over the top of your costume at all events, approximately \$70-\$80 (please note that this is a generic item and can be re-worn each year that it fits!)
- <u>IPC Costume/s: approximately \$80-\$90 + GST p/costume (billed Feb/March).</u> Please note that Dance Ensemble Members will have 2 x costumes billed. Hip Hop, Tap, Ballet + Musical Theatre ensembles have 1 x costume billed.
- <u>Competition Spectator Entry:</u> events charge an admission fee for spectators. Some are cash at the door per person, with other events charging a 'Registration Fee' per dancer instead. This is around \$30, and includes unlimited entry for as many family members and friends on the day (so there are no additional ticket/spectator prices on top of this).

Please note that we staff every competition, and communicate drop-off and pick-up times so that it is not compulsory for parents to have to stay at each event.

- Senior IPC Dance Ensemble (Yr 9 Yr 12): Senior IPC Dance Training Block & 1 x Ballet class

HIP HOP Crews

- Primary/Intermediate Hip Hop Crew (Yr 3-6): IPC Hip Hop Crew & 1 x additional Hip Hop Class
- Teen/Senior Hip Hop Crew (Yr 7-12): IPC Hip Hop Crew & 1 x additional Hip Hop Class
